Dear friends and family of OCUMC:

In the middle of Downtown Dallas, we came to a strange sight: a 30 foot eyeball that takes up half a city block. It is a piece of artwork that has spilled over from a hotel. When we told the hotel clerk that we were going to go see the piece, they asked, "What is it?" Never heard of it. Never seen it before. I wanted to say "It's a 30 foot eyeball in the middle of the city! How can you have missed this?" It made me think of the line from a Christmas song:

"Do You See What I See?"

Yes, it's in a Christmas carol - so why am I mentioning it here during another time of year?

Sometimes I feel like this is what God is asking me – "Do you see what I see?"

Do you see the young mother that needs encouragement? Do you see the child that needs hope? Do you see My love, My grace? Do you see?

It's so easy in our busy worlds to lose sight of the spiritual realm around us. I know in my own life I can become so focused on the physical and all that is going on around me, I miss seeing the reality of His work all around me.

It might sound simplistic - but we "see" what we focus on; and we're amazed that others don't see (or believe) what we see. A painter looks at the Grand Canyon and sees a masterful use of color and dimensions. A geologist sees the Grand Canyon and sees the history of a million years in the rocks and layers. A cowboy sees the Grand Canyon and thinks, "This is a horrible place to lose a cow." We see the world by what we focus on.

If you focus on how messed up this world is, either by watching too much news, lamenting with friends, reading/watching the daily struggles - you will find negativity in your life. If you take a break from the negative in your life, you will find more light and happiness. It really is that simple. And if we take a moment to read the words of another, we see the world though other people's eyes, as CS Lewis put it.

If someone could miss a giant eyeball a few blocks away for years, what could we miss in our daily walk? May we see what God sees. The pain, the suffering of others? But also the joy and lightheartedness in life? May we see ourselves as He sees us - a child of God.
