Dear friends and family of OCUMC:

Do you know the most widely quoted Psalm in the New Testament? You'd think it would be "The Lord is My Shepherd, I shall not want", or The Lord is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear?", or "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit", or "The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my savior; my God is my rock, in whom I find protection."

We can go on and on. These are all great lines in finding comfort and peace in troubling times.

But no, the most verse in the NT is from Psalm 22: "My God, My God, why has thou forsaken me?"
Surprised? I was surprised. But I also know human nature – and there are times when the world looks scary out there.

Forsaken is not a good place to be. Even Jesus quoted this line in his last moments on the cross. With the fears we have now, panic in the stores, panic on Wall Street, panic with our jobs, panic with being cooped up with our relatives (not being flippant, this is a real concern for some families); you can see why this Psalm still resonates today.

But if you go on with the Psalm, you might read, "Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the one Israel praises, in you our ancestors put their trust; they trusted and you delivered them. To you they cried out and were saved; in you they trusted and were not put to shame."

It feels weird not having "church".

But we are still the church – even in these times. I pray that you will join us in our online worship service. I pray that you continue to pray, serve, give, and witness in the ways that you can. At church, we are still keeping office hours and continue to show the Gospel – your gifts help make that happen as we help those in need.


