Dear friends and family of OCUMC:

In our last worship service, our Staff Parish Chair Melissa Quevedo read a letter from our District Superintendent, Wendy Woodworth. In case you missed it - here is the message:

Dear friends and members of Oregon City First UMC,

Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ!

For nearly eight years, you have been blessed with the gift of Rev. Mike Benischek as your pastor. He has served you with energy, joy, passion, and the desire to help you grow in vitality and mission to your community. Under his leadership, you have accomplished significant financial goals and your growth in mission and ministry is inspiring!

As you know, United Methodist clergy serve in an itinerant system under the authority of the bishop. This letter is to inform you that Bishop Elaine Stanovsky of the Greater Northwest Episcopal Area intends to appoint Rev. Mike Benischek as pastor of Meridian UMC in Meridian, Idaho effective July 1, 2021. This decision was reached after prayerful discernment by both the Cabinet and Mike and his family.

I know that this announcement was not anticipated nor invited by you. Please know that I hold you in prayer as you receive this news.

The Cabinet is in deep discernment about who can follow Mike as your pastor. I will be in consultation with your SPRC about this. Our hope and goal are to provide you with the pastoral leadership you need to continue your growth and mission in Oregon City. You are an important, significant congregation in our conference. We want you to move from strength to strength. I request that your prayers be added to those of the Cabinet as we move forward with this process.

Mike will be your pastor through June. I know you will find ways to show your appreciation to Mike and his family. I know you will find ways to celebrate Mike's new appointment, while also feeling the grief of this change in relationship. As hard as this is, I trust that the Holy Spirit is at work in powerful ways in this process and especially through your gracious spirit. I thank God for each of you and pray you will be Christ in the community and Christ to one another.


